MARKING SYSTEM: Sportident (not Air)
We can lend SI for a price $2 €$ per race (in case of damage or loss of SI you will need to pay $40 €$ )

In case of failure of the SI unit, the competitor marks the passage of a control by replacement mechanical stamping anywhere on the map and he points out this fact immediately at the finish line and hands over the map to the finish referee.

## PRIZES AND CEREMONIES:

After each stage first three competitors will receive certificate of award.
OVERALL RESULTS: First three competitors in each category will receive certificate of award and commemorative prices. (The smallest sum of placements from all stages)

## INFORMATION:

We kindly ask all participants to separate trash in finish areas to individual trash cans. Also not to crush plastic bottles.

Drink refreshment will be available in each finish area and on each stage, except sprint, on one common fox.
Draft beer and kofola will be available in finish area for free. Each competitor will receive a ticket for one meal at finish.

We will provide transportation of baggage from start to finish on every stage.

Medical personnel will be available to treat any minor injuries in finish area on every stage.

Start numbers must be worn on all stages and competitors must make sure that the start number is visibly mounted on chest.

## EVENT COORDINATES:

Finish area will be held inside of Museum of the Slovak Village which is located 800m from parking.

PARKING: Coordinates of primary parking lot: $49.0438403 \mathrm{~N}, 18.9240825 \mathrm{E}$ parking lot is under camera surveillance.

TERRAIN DESCRIPTION: Small forest with mixed vegetation divided to several parts situated around the museum, surrounded by meadows and fields from all sides, mowed grasslands of the museum with several isolated forests and many small houses, there may be presence of animal pens.

## REGISTRATION:

For those with accommodation - registration at the venue center is required beforehand
For the rest - registration will be available at the event center please take into account that registration might take up to 10 minutes!

TRAINING: Until 14:45 in the vicinity of the finish area
QUARANTINE: 15 minutes before start 00 any entrance to and from the start area will be forbidden. Competitors must be present in start area 15 minutes before start 00. Finish quarantine will not be held but we ask competitors for fair play behavior.

HANDING OVER RECEIVERS: Until 15:00 - competitors who disobey this rule may disqualified from the race. Receivers will be collected at finish area and will be transported to start by organizers.

## CORRIDORS:

One starting corridor for all categories
Corridor from S: 100m, double-sided
Finish corridor: 150 m
NOTES: Competitors do not need to pay any visit fee to enter the museum. This does not apply to visitor which need to pay. Competitors may walk around the museum before the quarantine and after their finish. We urge everyone to follow the rules of museum. Do not cross any fences, do not enter the historical houses, do not cross any fields or any agricultural land, do not leave any litter behind! Competitors who disobey these rules will be disqualified and may be fined by the museum management! We kindly ask you to respect this landmarks and to behave responsibly.
